## Luton & District Ladies Triples Bowls League Competition Rules

- 1. The League shall be known as the Luton and District Triples Bowls League.
- All League games and competitions shall be played under the Rules of Bowls England and shall be under the management of the Executive of the Luton and District Ladies Triples Bowls League.
- 3. A team shall consist of six players i.e. two triples.
- 4. A player once playing for a team cannot play for another team during that year.
- 5. A game shall consist of eighteen ends.
- A game shall be played straight off, no trial ends with all shots counting.
- 7. MATCH PLAY: Two points shall be awarded to the team with the most shots. If there is a tie on shots then one point will be awarded to each team.
- 8. GAMES RAINED OFF: Fifteen shots shall be awarded to each team, plus one point if less than ten ends have been played, but both teams must try to rearrange the game before the end of the season. If the teams cannot come to an arrangement to play the game during that time, the Committee will award the above: if ten or more ends have been played by at least one triple the score is to stand, the Home Captain to notify League Secretary accordingly.
- 9. Any match not played by the given date must be reported to the League Secretary by the Captain cancelling the game. The Opposing captain must then offer two alternate dates to the defaulting Captain, one of which she must accept within two days, otherwise two points and fifteen shots will be awarded to the opposing team.
- 10. The League shall run as many divisions as required. If more than one division is formed there will be promotion and relegation with two teams up and two teams down.
- 11. Games shall be played on a Tuesday, starting no later than 6.15 p.m. or on a date before that on the fixture card. This must be arranged by both Captains.
- 12. The match sheets must be signed by both skips and sent to the League Secretary by first class mail within 24 hoursof the game by the Home Captains.
- 13. Players may be "signed on" on the evening of a game. The form must be signed by the opposing Captain and sent to the League Secretary along with the signing on fee as soon as possible.
- 14. Entrance fee to the League is £6 per team plus £1 per player. Entrance fee for the Knockout Cup is to be £4 per team or such other amounts as may be agreed at an AGM.
- 15. Full Committee to be the League Executive plus one delegate from each club.
- 16. If after completion of the fixtures, there are teams level on points, shots for and against will be taken into consideration.
- 17. CHANGE OF RULES: Notice of any change to the rules must be given to the League Secretary at least 28 days before the AGM which will be held in February each year.
- 18. When playing in the knockout competition, in the event of a draw after eighteen ends an extra end shall be played by one triple to determine the winner. The triple playing the extra end shall be selected before the commencement of the game by the toss of a coin. For semi finals and finals only, trial ends will be permitted and skips can visit the head. After the Semi Finals of the Knockout teams can replace players for Knockout Final.
- 19. Substitutes. The player must be named before the game, the substitution <u>must</u> take place after nine ends and the substitute cannot play at skip. Substitute must be noted on the result sheet.
